ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- U.S. Citizen.
- Academic Level - Successfully completed at least two undergraduate years at an accredited 4-year college, community college, or university.
- Active Enrollment- Actively enrolled in an accredited school or university.
- Career goals- Interest in pursuing a career in medicine or a STEM field.
