Gulf War Veteran Illness

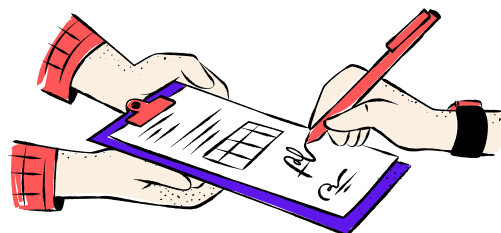
Gulf War Veteran Illness that affects Gulf War Veterans is a cluster of medically unexplained chronic symptoms that can include fatigue, headaches, joint pain, indigestion, insomnia, dizziness, respiratory disorders, and memory problems.

Who is Enrolled?

All service members who served during 1990-1991 are eligible for our study. Men and women from 42 states and from all branches of service are enrolled!

Goal of Study

This is a longitudinal research study with the goal of brain and spinal tissue donation after passing. During your lifetime you will provide important data over the phone, email and mail once a year.
